Your reunion will be a hit in Columbus. There's plenty of fun ways to catch up and get reacquainted in Ohio's capital city.

DAY ONE

Meet prominent figures from Ohio's history on a guided tour of the **Ohio Statehouse**. Be a guest at "Miss Emma's Table," named for a local socialite who lived beside the Ohio Statehouse in the 1800s. You'll be treated to an old-fashioned boarding-house style meal.

Challenge your inner explorer and have fun learning about science in Adventure, an Indian Jones-like hands-on exhibition area at **COSI**. This is an ideal team-building activity for reunions. Work together to uncover clues and go on an archaeological dig.



Work as a team at COSI

Head to one of Columbus' parks for a cookout or barbecue. Among your choices are the **Park of Roses**, one of the county's largest municipal rose gardens, and **Franklin Park**, which surrounds the acclaimed Franklin Park Conservatory filled with botanical displays.



Play at Magic Mountain

Later, explore **Easton Town Center**, one of the Midwest's top shopping, dining and entertainment destinations. Or head to **Magic Mountain Fun Center**. There's a reason "fun" is part of the name—activities include bumper boats, laser tag, go-karts, miniature golf and an arcade.

DAY TWO

Eat breakfast with the animals at the **Columbus Zoo and Aquarium**. Interact with exotic animals up-close and learn from the experts after enjoying a full breakfast buffet. Find out more behind-the-scenes information on a guided walking tour, before the gates open to the public.



Touch exotic animals

Make a big splash at **Zoombezi Bay**—the wildest water park ever. Located next to the Columbus Zoo and Aquarium, the 22.7-acre park

lets you experience the thrill of speeding down 15 water slides, the adrenaline rush of the wave pool, the calm of the lazy river and more. Admission to Zoombezi Bay includes the zoo, so you can go back and forth between the parks all day.
